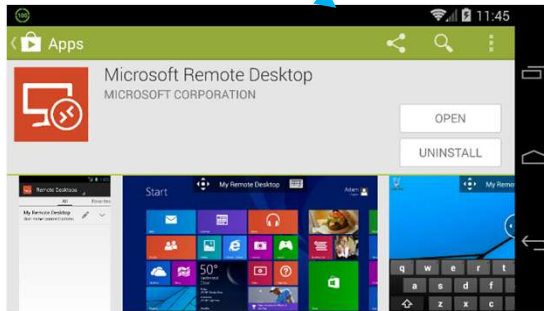


Connect to NBI Remote Desktop Services

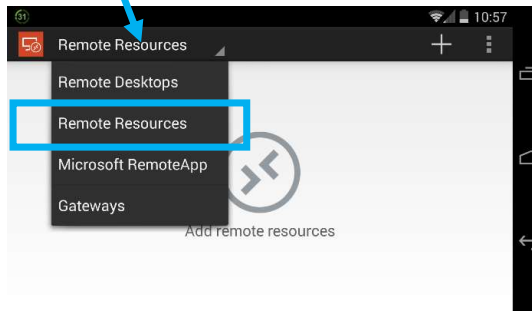

Install **Microsoft Remote Desktop** from the Play Store



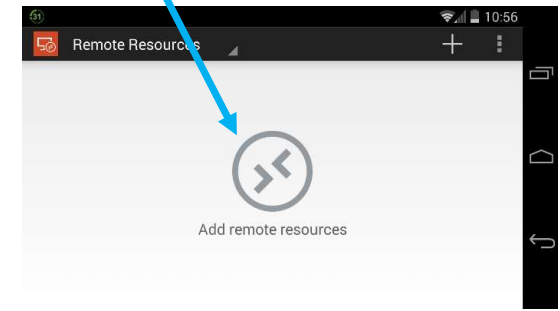

Tap centre of screen to **Add remote resources**



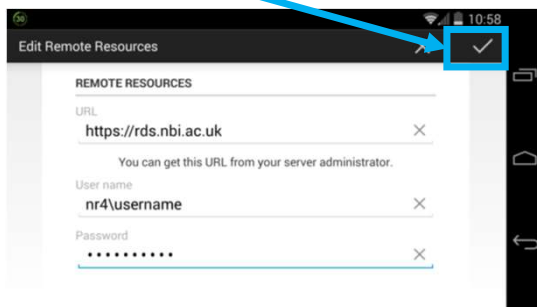

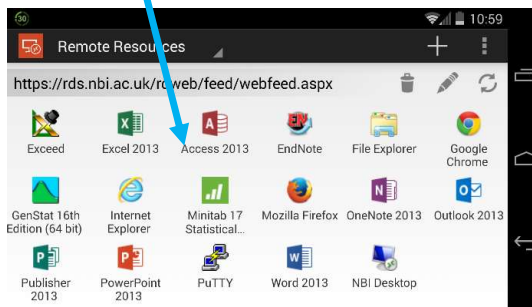

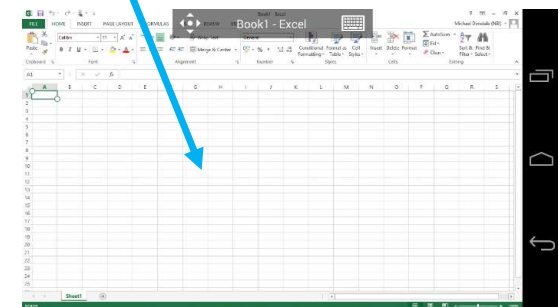
The **RD Client** will display a list of available applications to choose from. Tap the required application to launch it.

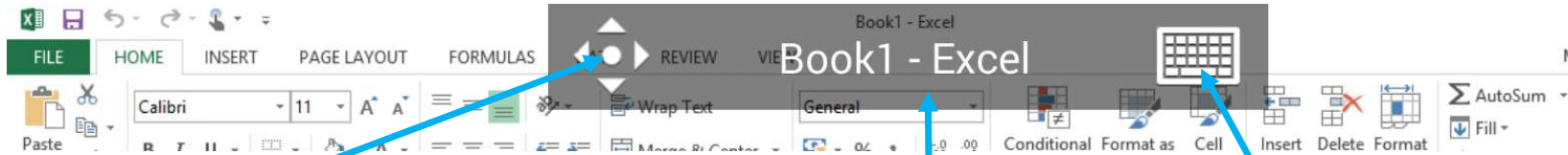
The example below shows Excel running on an Android phone
